4	<p><u>Weaving & Textiles - Half Day</u> Start your day visit Lao Textiles Museum Lao is quite well known for its silk women products. The country's Silk fabric is appreciated for its exquisite beauty and fine workmanship. The technique used is sophisticated and potentially one of the most complex weaving techniques that exists. It requires as high level of perseverance and artistic talent to create exquisite fabrics, whose colors are natural products dyes. Weaving, as practiced by Lao people, depicts their way of life, their environment and spiritualbeliefs and is thought by many to be an example of successful combination of the local knowledge and silk of the people of South East Asia. The curious mind may ask how Lao people used to produce silk fabrics, considered as masterpieces in their own right, hundreds of years before, at a time when commercial competition was not common. You can find answers to these questions and more at the Lao Textile Museum, Its a place worthwhile visiting. The Lao Textile Museum is the first private museum in Laos. On display are antique pieces of silk made by difference ethnic group of the country. Visitors can also see ancient house hold utensils. Its central position (in front of the night market and beside the Royal Palace) makes it one of the most visited temples of this ancient royal town and Vat Sene This temple's name is said to come from a donation of 100,000 Kip (Sene kip) which was used to construct the temple in 1718. Restored in 1957, on the occasion of the 2500th anniversary of the birth of the Buddha, Vat Sene also houses two long boats which are used in the annual Boat Racing Festival. 4	<p><u>Luang Prabang - Weaving Full day</u></p> <p>Pick-up at your hotel and head out to see Phone Say village for a visit, which lies hidden along the Mekong River, just a few kilometers from the city center. Phone Say is one of the most intact traditional Lao villages in the area. Here, almost 100% of women work with textiles while men make traps for fishing on the Mekong. This hidden, charming village cannot be reached by vehicles, but is just half an hour walk from the main road.</p> <p>Although close to the city, entering the village is like entering another world with the rattle of weavers' looms clacking away all day long. Late in the afternoon, you'll attend an Ock Pop Tok - a seminar on sericulture, natural dyes, weaving techniques, and symbolism in Lao textiles.</p> <p>Many visitors are overwhelmed by the beauty and quantity of Lao textiles and our seminar will answer some of the frequently asked questions. Joanna and Veo are experienced speakers, having lectured in Australia, Singapore, Thailand and the US. The talk takes place in a covered part of our workshop along the banks of the Mekong.</p> <p>During the seminar, we'll serve cocktails and you will be able to enjoy a peaceful sunset over the mystic Mekong. Guests walk with the elephants through the jungle as they interact with each other and forage on native foods. MandaLao guides continue to explain elephant behavior as they guide guests through the forest. The trek is 2.5 Km and takes about 1.5 hours, it is flat and shaded most of the way. Then continue trekking, Guests trek a total of 5.5Km on Inside the Hearts of Elephants.
